

Socks in Minecraft pattern

After quite a long time comes once again a knitting pattern for socks recommendation from me. While browsing the internet, I became aware of the "Minecraft" pattern. There are different variations of this pattern, which is knitted with right and left stitches only.

Minecraft first made me think of the game, but there are similarities 😊 Well visible blocks. I enjoyed the pattern. It's simple but looks like a lot. I also knitted the boomerang heel for the first time on the socks. Otherwise, I always knit the classic heel, as my mom taught me years ago. But it was time for something new 😊 It also worked quite well, although sometimes I have not pulled the thread tight enough and now have a few small holes.

I knitted the two pairs of socks with 6-thread sock wool, but the pattern also works with a 4- or 8-thread wool. The total number of stitches on all needles needs to be divisible by 4.

You can make the socks with a cuff (e.g. 5-10 cm alternating 2 stitches right and 2 stitches left) or start the pattern right away.

But first the sequence if you started with a cuff:

3 rows: right stitches

3 rows: alternating 2 sts left, 2 sts right

3 rows: right stitches

3 rows: alternate 2 sts right, 2 sts left

and again from the beginning 😊

If you want to knit without a cuff, just start with the 2nd block, so alternate 2 sts right, 2 sts left.

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
